

1. CONNECTION

As an installer, you can access your dashboard after completing the registration process. Your distributor first needs to create your professional account using your email address.

Once this step is completed, you'll automatically receive an **email containing a link** to set **your password**.

These credentials (**your email address and created password**) will then grant you access to your personal installer portal.

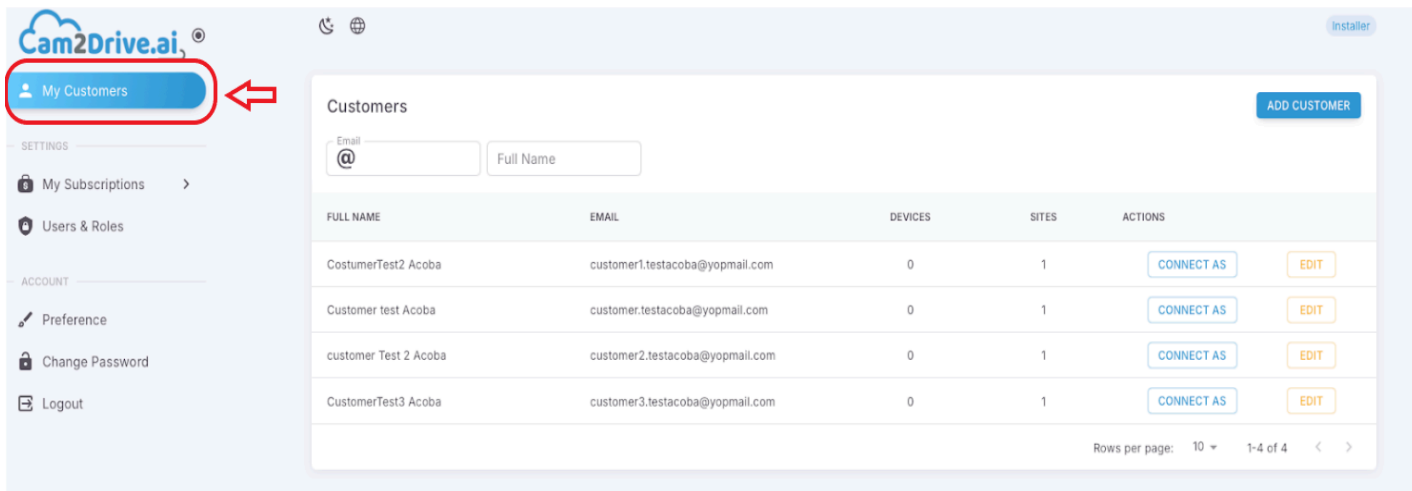

2. DISPLAY CUSTOMER LIST

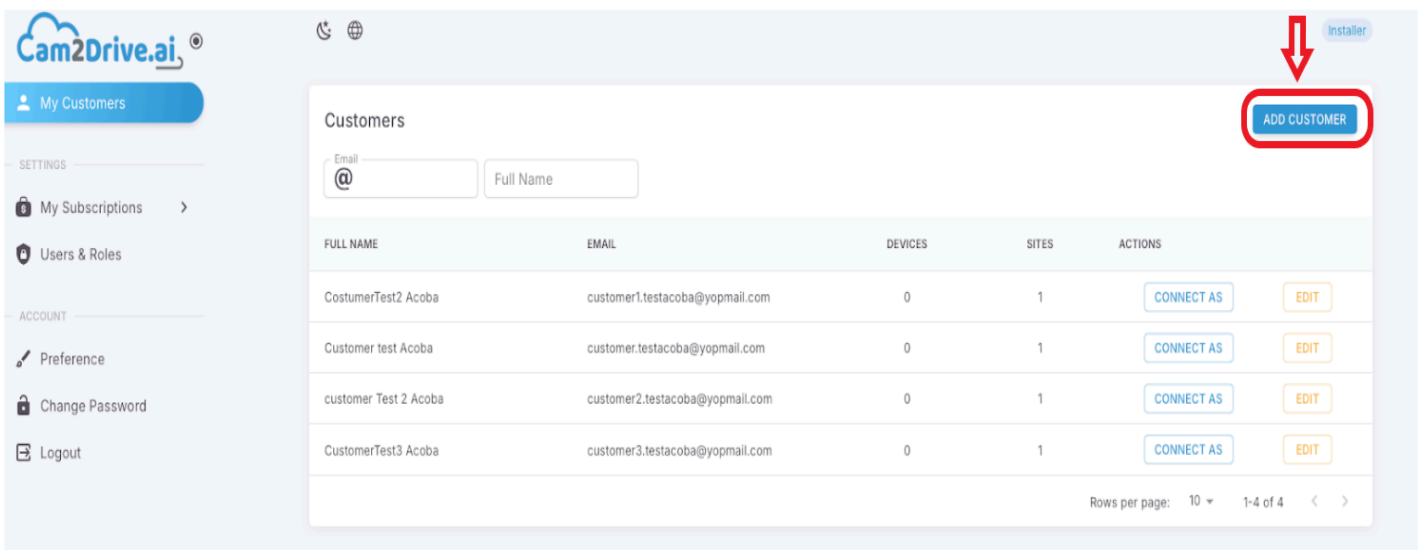
Once logged in, the left menu displays: My Customers , Settings (My subscriptions , User & Rôles), Account (Preference , Change Password , Logout).

Click My Customers to view and manage all your clients

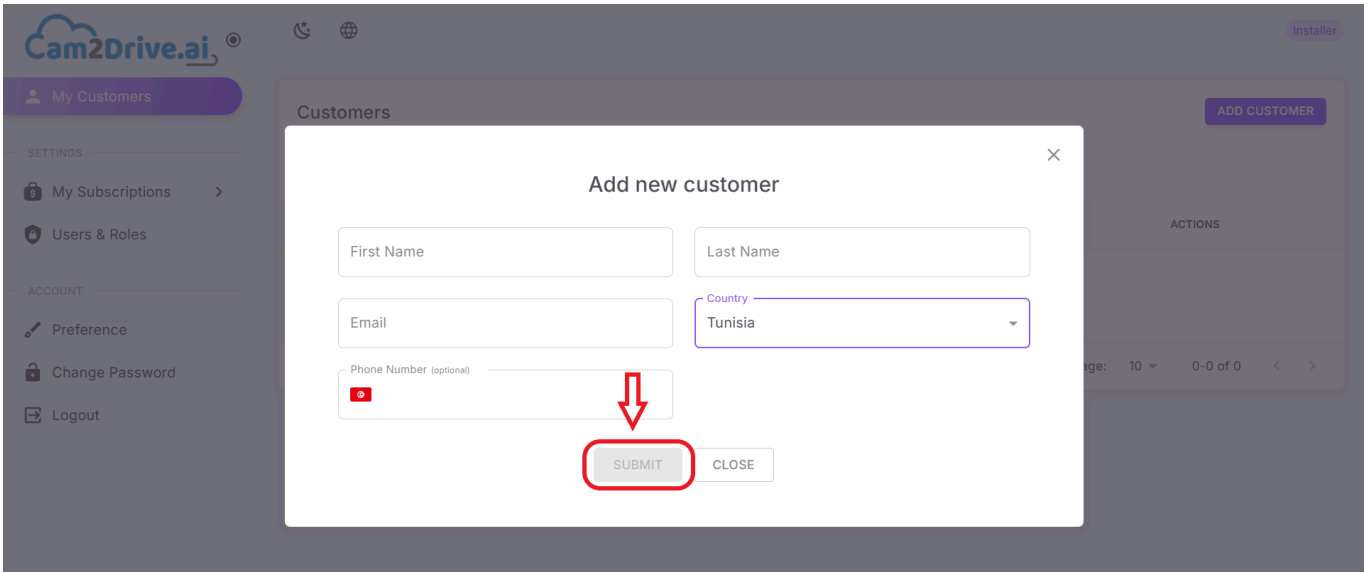


2.1. ADD CUSTOMER

To add a new customer, simply click the "Add Customers" button

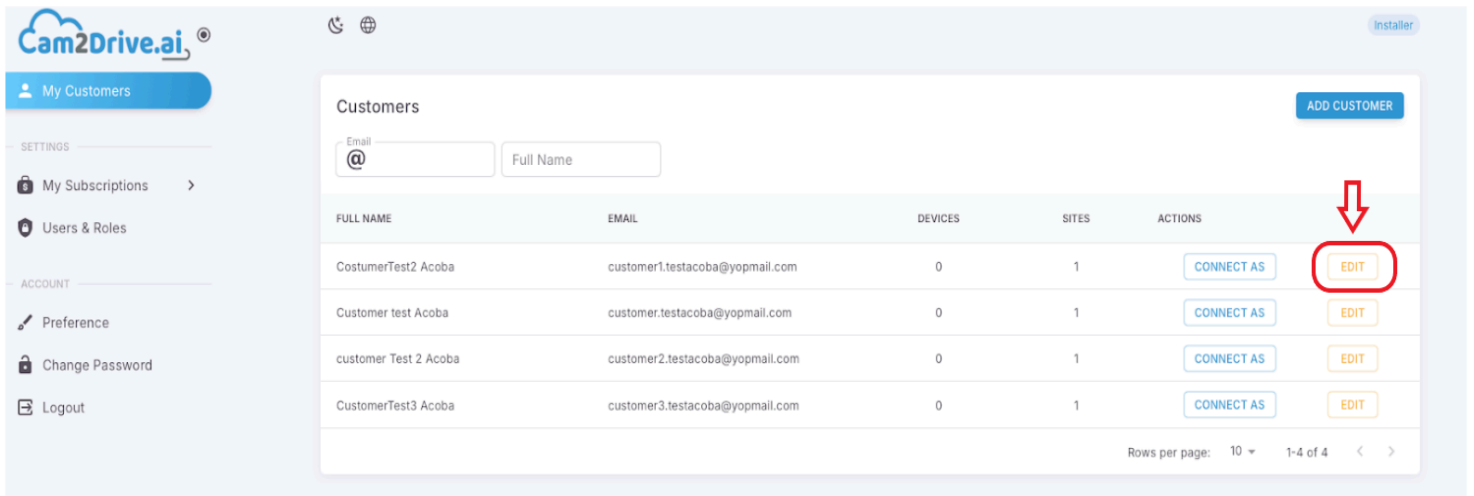


Then fill in the required information in the displayed form and click in the “**Submit**” button , as shown in the image below:



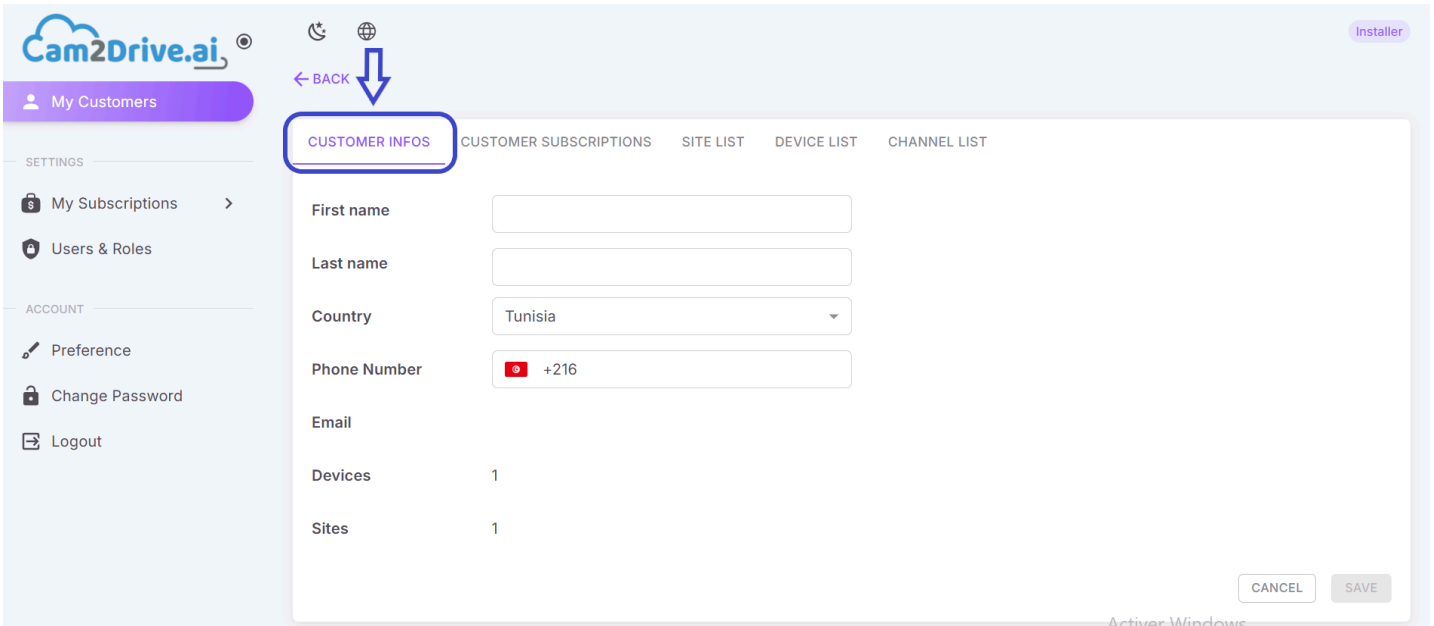
2.2. EDIT CUSTOMER

To edit a customer, simply click the "**Edit**" button as shown below

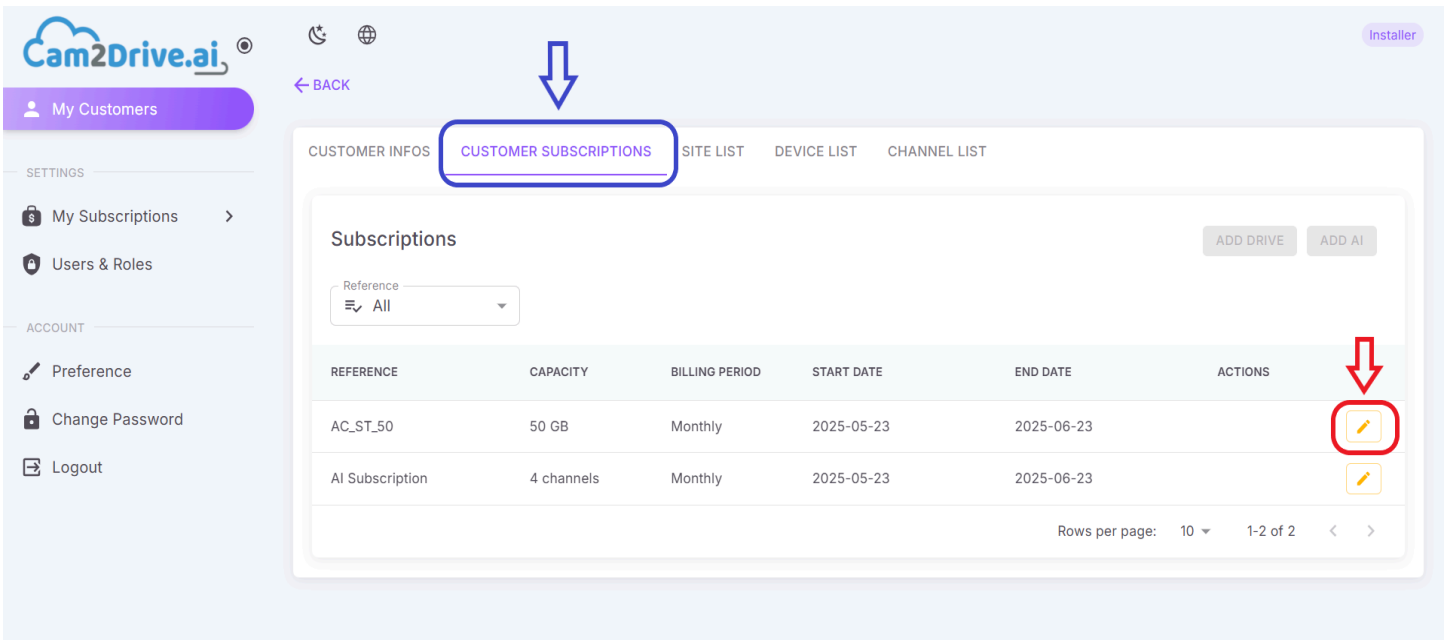


From the customer interface, you can edit:

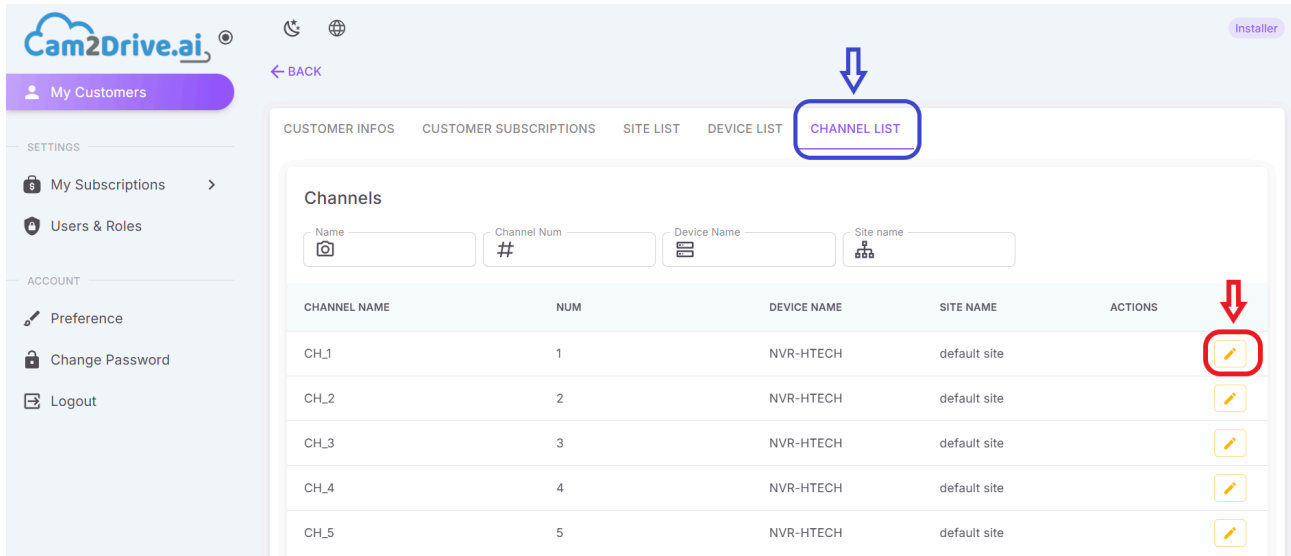

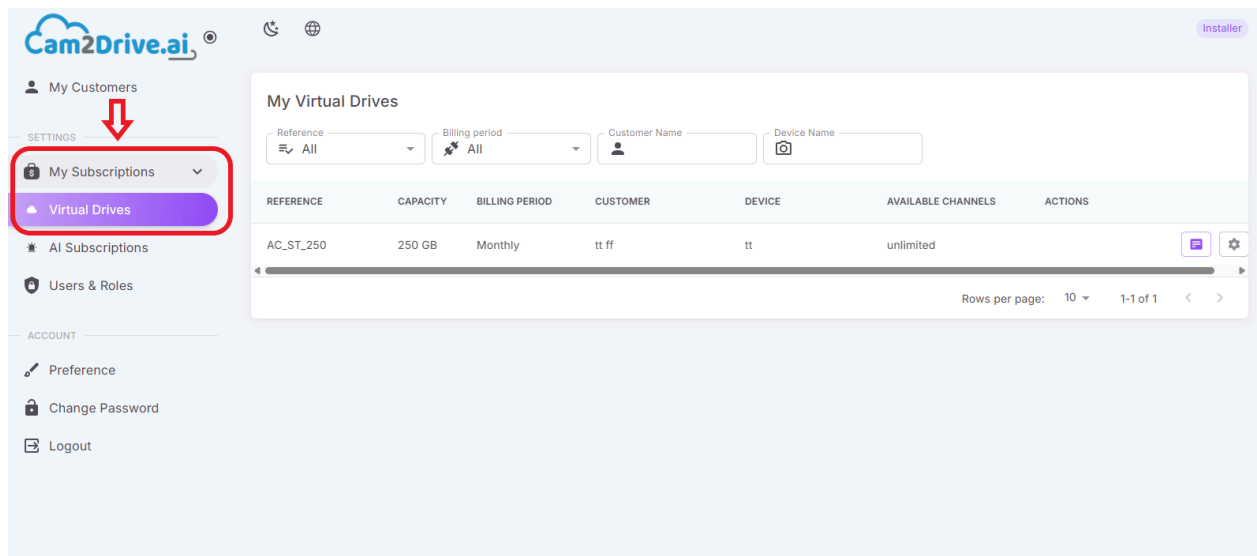
3. SUBSCRIPTIONS

- AI Subscription - Advanced analytics service

3.1. VIRTUAL DRIVES:

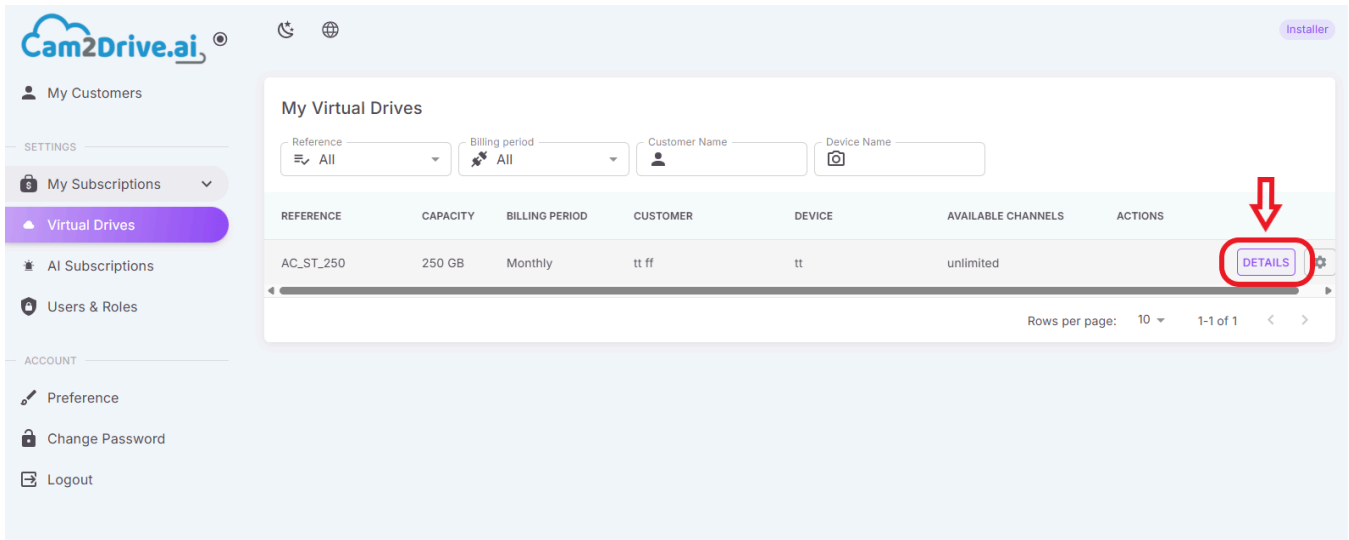
To manage Virtual Drive subscriptions, navigate to "My Subscriptions" and select "Virtual Drives" to view the complete list of customer subscriptions.



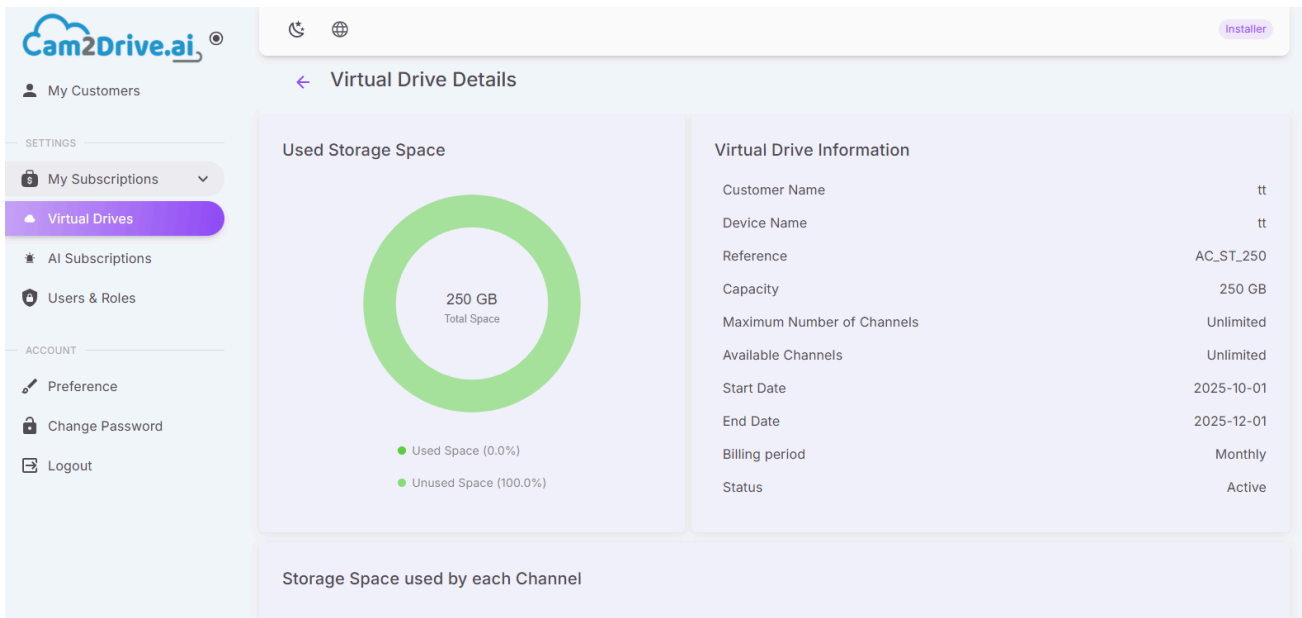
Additionally, the installer can view details of each subscription and configure the user's virtual drive

Click the 'Details' button to view details including:

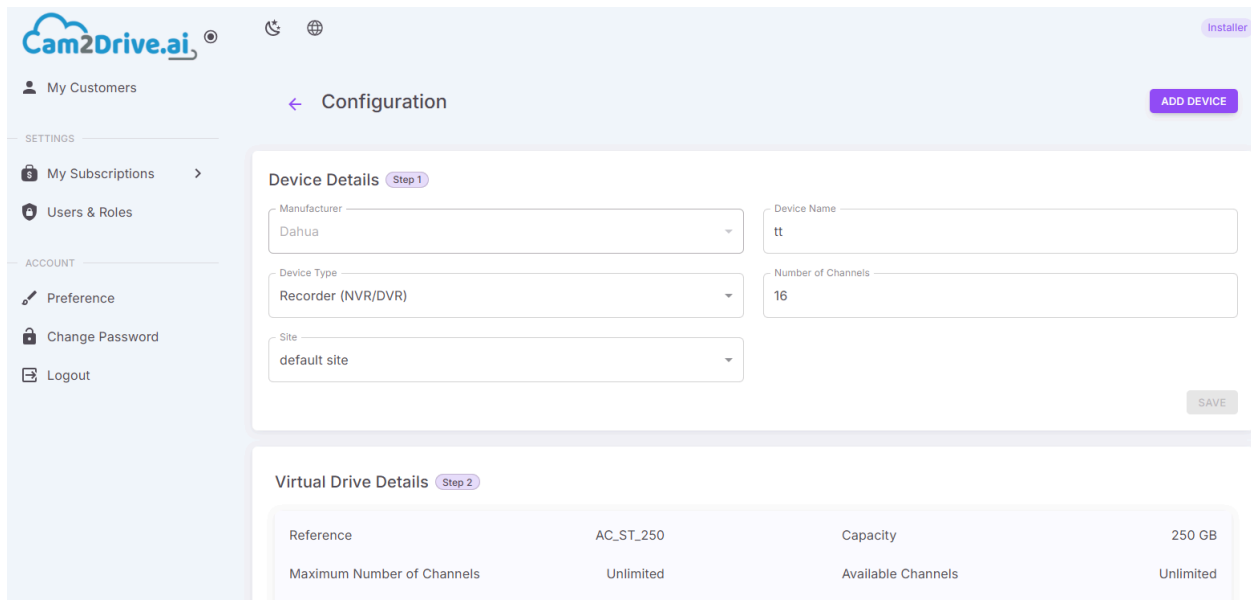
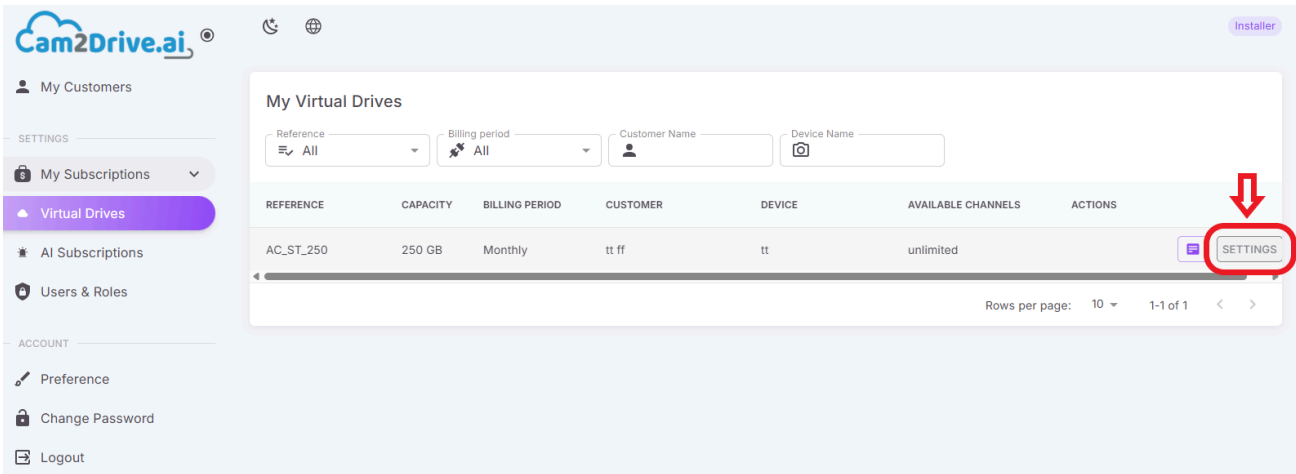


- Used Storage Space

3.1.2. Configuration :

Configuration of Virtual Drives follows a streamlined 5-step process :



Step 1 : Device Details

Step 2 : Virtual Drive Details

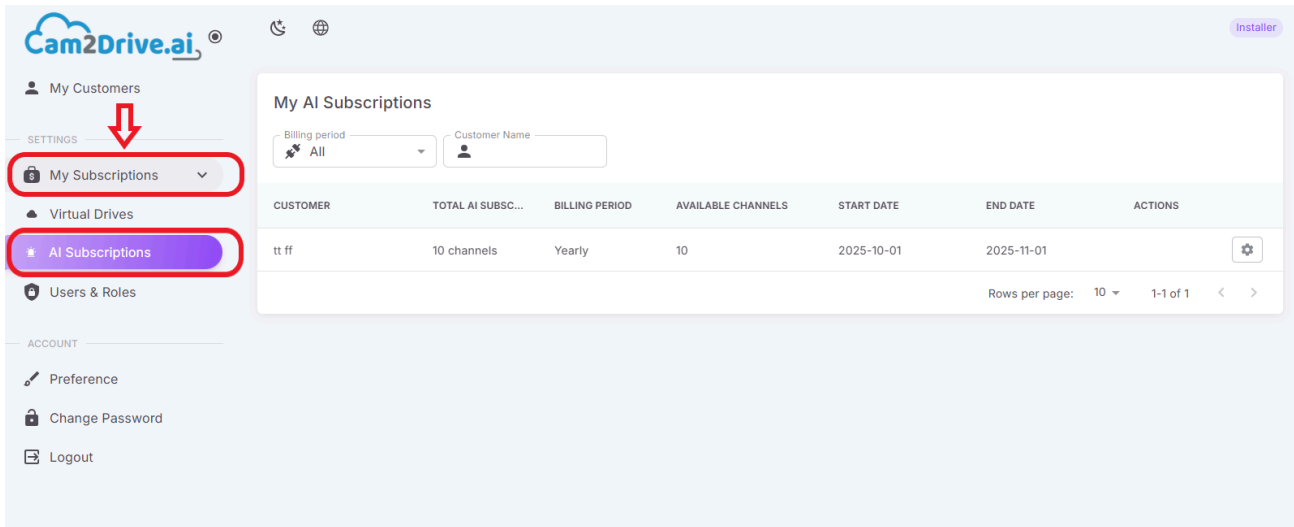
Step 3 : AI subscription information (optional step)

Step 4 : channels list (Configure your channels: name, cloud backup, and AI algorithms used)

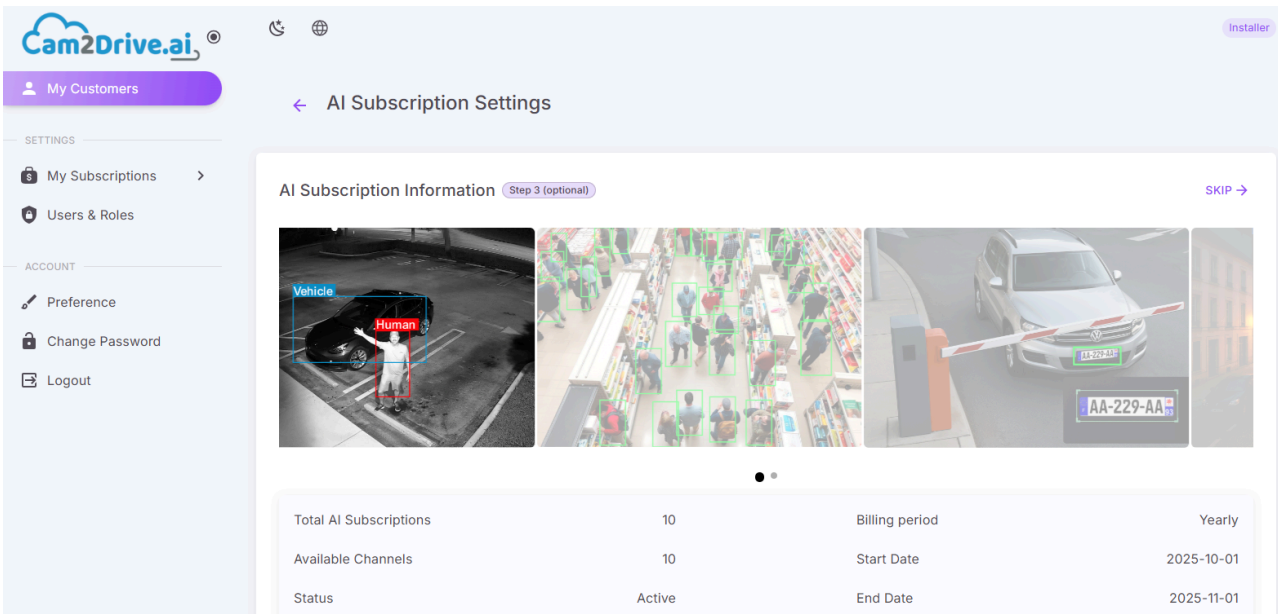
Step 5 : Device-to-Cloud Connection Settings

3.2. AI SUBSCRIPTIONS:

To manage AI subscriptions, navigate to "My Subscriptions" and select "AI Subscriptions" to view the complete list of customer AI subscriptions.



Additionally, the installer can view details of each subscription and configure the user's virtual drive, with the details available in the customer dashboard
